

Maintenance

Lalegno's Engineered Oak floors are really easy to keep clean and generally only require daily vacuuming. They don't need to be damp mopped every day, and spot cleaning using a damp cloth after vacuuming will be sufficient in most cases.

A good clean every 2 weeks can be done using one of the **LALEGNO CLEANER** floor cleaning products we supply, using a microfiber mop.

Oiled floors need to be re-oiled on average every 24 months depending on usage. This can be done quickly by a professional or DIY using a buffing machine and a clear oil. In between these re oils it is possible to buff surface scratches and dry spots with clear oil and or neat **LALEGNO CLEANER** and a microfiber cloth.

Lacquered floors don't require any periodic maintenance. Between 5 and 10 years the floor can be re-sanded and sealed, depending on usage and wear. The floor does not need to be lifted. Sanding and re coloring takes place onsite.

Engineered floors can be sanded to rejuvenate and to change the color. 3-4 times with a 4mm veneer, this is color dependent.
